The following images show the development as you should see it during the incubation period on the prescribed days. These images were taken using a BrinseaTM Ova-Scope and Standard Ova-View Egg Candler. Use these images to monitor the eggs in your classroom. Remember that you may see a variation of what is pictured due to varying shell densities.





Day 0 - A fresh egg.



Day 6 of Development



Day 13 of Development



Day 19 of Development



This egg stopped developing within the first week of the incubation process.



This egg never actually developed or was not fertilized.
